## Short Profile

Before joining the Augustinians of the Assumption (Assumptionists) in 2001, Fr. Alex was a teacher for 9 years at Assumpta Technical High School, one of the mission schools of the Religious of the Assumption in the Philippines. He did his novitiate at St. Anne's Shrine, Sturbridge, MA in August, 2003, and professed his first vows a year after. In January, 2016 he was assigned to the Philippines as one of the founders of the first Assumptionist community in Manila. He obtained his Masters in Religious Education at the Formation Institute for Religion Educators (FIRE) at the Ateneo de Manila University in May 2006. He finished his Seminary Program (Bachelor in Sacred Theology) at the Ecclesiastical Faculty of Sacred Theology of the Royal and Pontifical University of Santo Tomas (UST) in March, 2009, graduating Cum Laude. He professed his perpetual vows in August, 2009. He was the Formator for the Postulants of the Philippine Delegation from 2009 to 2011. He was ordained to the diaconate in October 31, 2010, and served as deacon at the National Shrine of Our Lady of Peace and Good Voyage, Antipolo City. He was ordained to the priesthood in November 12, 2011 at Loyola Heights, Quezon City by the Archbishop of Manila, Luis Antonio Cardinal Tagle. After his ordination he was assigned in Worcester, MA, as Assistant Novice Master for the Province of North America and the Philippines. In September, 2014, he was transferred to the Brighton, MA community as US Delegation Treasurer, and Assistant to the Provincial Treasurer. Currently, he is a member of the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees of Assumption College, and since October 2016, was appointed as the Provincial Treasurer. His interests are in the field of liturgy, history and archives.
